	JEB DUNNUCK	Mars 2023: Sweet cherries, raspberries, spring flowers, and cedary spice notes emerge from the 2020 Château Patris Querre, a medium-bodied, elegant 2020 with ripe, firm tannins, good overall balance and outstanding length. It shows the vintage's firmer, focused, elegant style and will benefit from 2-3 years of bottle age and cruise over the following decade. It's an attractive, elegant wine that has lots to like.
Libut Cake C5 Wine Advocate	ROBERT PARKER	Juin 2021: 89/91 Deep purple-black colored, the 2020 Patris Querre opens with expressive scents of plum preserves, blueberry jam and redcurrant jelly, plus wafts of licorice and black olives. Medium to full-bodied, the palate delivers energetic black fruits with spicy accents and a velvety texture, finishing long and fragrant.
	JAMES SUCKLING	Avril 2021: 92 / 93 A medium-bodied red with blackberry, chocolate and some walnut undertones. Attractive, fine tannins with some chewiness. Avril 2021: 88 / 89 pour le Blanc
	MARKUS DEL MONEGO	Avril 2021: 91 Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Elegant nose with fine fruit, elderberries, mulberries and hints of ripe plums. On the palate firm tannins, juicy fruit, good aromatic length and aromatic depth.
