



	<p>JAMES SUCKLING</p>	<p>Février 2017 : 90 Dried-cranberry, earthy and citrus notes wrap nicely around a solid core of rather dry tannins. Maybe the finish is a bit short, but this has good harmony. Drink now.</p>
	<p>NEAL MARTIN eROBERTPARKER.COM</p>	<p>Avril 2015 : 90 / 92 The Château Patris Querre 2014 is tightly wound on the nose, but there is good fruit concentration here, nicely defined with a sense of freshness and vitality. The palate is medium-bodied with crisp acidity, quite masculine and structured with good backbone, but there is the fruit to back this all up. I like the reserved nature of this wine, but I have a feeling that it will spring out of the box, once it is in bottle. Look out for this—a very satisfying Saint Emilion on the cards.</p>
